Rules & Regulations

1. Tractors 1959 and older only.
2. Tire sizes are as follows: No radial tires. No cut or shaved tires.

0-5000 lbs. 170 sq.in Max	5001-6500 lbs. 229 sq.in Max	7000-7500 250 sq. in Max	8000 lbs. Up
13.6 x 38- 168 sq. in.	14.9 x 38 – 200 sq. in.	16.9 x 38 – 252 sq. in.	OPEN

3. Tractors weigh with driver.
4. Twenty percent (20%) RPM allowance over factory settings.
5. Weights:
 - Max of 11 feet from center of rear axle to further most point.
 - Rear weights are not to exceed past the rear wheel.
 - A 12 – inch window in the center required to aid hooking and unhooking.
6. All tractors **MUST** be original in appearance. Factory air cleaners must be installed and working.
7. Tractors may pull in first or second gear only.
8. Drawbar must not exceed twenty one (21) inches in height or less than eighteen (18) inches from center of rear axle to hooking point.
9. Pull is ended by one of the following:
 - Flagman.
 - Driver does not remain seated.
 - Anything falls off tractor.
 - Tractor or sled gets out of the track.
 - All forward motion of tractor and/or sled stops.
10. First puller has the option to re-pull in the third position. First pull is void if re-pull is taken. Decision **MUST** be made before unhooking.
11. Tractor may pull once per class.
12. Tractors may pull up to three weight classes. Depending on track conditions & time allowed.
13. No excessive jerking of sled.
14. No shifting of torque amplifier during pull.
15. If you contest a tractor, it must be in your class during your pull in that class. Protester must be checked first.
16. Each class will be pulled in order of register. Mechanical breakdown or weight changes will move tractor to end class. If then unable to pull, tractor is disqualified.
17. Puller has two attempts of make pull. Any distance of 25 feet will be counted as a valid pull.
18. Track judges or committee members of Ozark Highlanders has the right to disqualify any tractor.
Their decision will be final.
19. 3.5 MPH speed limit. Pull ends once horn sounds after front of sled passes a 75 foot marker.
 - 5 MPH speed limit for 8000 lbs. or more.
20. Sled operator, hook man, flagger, weigh master make up track committee and reserves the right to protest any tractor.
21. There is no changing classes once the first hook of the pull is hooked.
22. Only driver and 1 coach may be on the track during the pull.
23. All drivers must be able to safely operate tractor unassisted.
