

33rd Annual Meramec Community Fair Parade

“Barnyard Mardi Gras”

“Barnyard Mardi Gras” is the theme for the 33rd Annual Meramec Community Fair. The Parade will begin at 6:00 pm, Tuesday evening, June 18th, 2019. The parade starts at the Sullivan City Hall, continues up Clark Street to Springfield Road, making a left and continuing down Springfield Road to Park Street, making a left onto Park Street and continuing down to Bill Thurmond Memorial Drive, making a right onto that street and ending at the Skating Rink, with the exception of the Queen contestants who will continue directly to the Fairgrounds.

If you have several children riding on your entry, please arrange drop off and pick up locations away from the parade route to prevent unnecessary traffic congestion. Each year we have several children, and adults who are unable to locate their entry in the lineup. Arranged meeting locations will alleviate this problem.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE CHAMBER PRIOR TO JUNE 14TH TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION

Important Reminder: Line up will be at 5:00 pm. All entries should enter the assembly area by heading up Church Street in front of the fire station to the corner of East Vine and Church. Someone will direct each entry to the proper location from that point. Do NOT bring floats and vehicles to City Hall for lineup.

Three and four wheelers will not be allowed on the street unless entered in the parade, decorated and ridden by an adult.

Floats: There are two difficult corners, the one at Watson’s Florist and the other at the Main Street turn to cross the railroad tracks. They are narrow, so we suggest you execute as wide a turn as possible to maneuver the corners.

If you plan on throwing candy, please toss it completely off the street. In the past, children have run between floats, under horses and in front of cars to pick up the candy. **All “wheeled” entries distributing candy, soft drinks, premiums, etc. MUST provide 1 person walking on each side to prevent children from running too close to the wheels. This includes floats, cars, trucks, & buggies.** Please keep safety in mind as we get ready for the 2018 Fair.

Trophy Hopefuls: You will receive your judging number when we receive your entry form before the day of the parade. The number must be displayed on the driver’s door of the vehicle or on the left side of your entry if there is not a vehicle involved. Please contact the office prior to the Parade if you misplace your number. Judges will be located at Radio Shack. You do not have to be judged to enter the parade!

Remember: Season passes to the Fair are only \$35 for all three days of carnival rides, track events, the Queen Pageant, and all entertainment. Purchase your 3-day pass by June 20th. Passes available at the Chamber of Commerce and at the gate on June 20th.
